

Clinton County Ken Mitchell Monthly Report  
July 2024

1. Utility Scale Battery Ordnance
  - a. Discussion at board meeting with the 3 opposed to the proposed ordnance.
  - b. Those commissioners were asked to make their concerns known to the planning commission.
  - c. Planning commission is reviewing this and several other ordnance's.
2. Central Dispatch
  - a. Authorized Central Dispatch to upgrade software and add licensing and to purchase hardware and services for the current MDT system not to exceed \$100,000.
  - b. It was originally planned to be well in excess of this amount.
3. Clinton County Veteran Affairs
  - a. After discussion voted to put \$4,746.00 into a new fund for a Veterans Emergency Fund.
  - b. This fund would be used to help Clinton County Veterans with special issues when no other funding is available.
  - c. This fund will be monitored to see if it needs to be increased.
  - d. This operation will be a partnership with the Director of Ingham and Clinton County Department of Veteran Affairs.
4. Special Meeting
  - a. A special W/M meeting was scheduled for July 18 @ 9am to discuss certain ordnance's from the planning commission.
5. New Funding for Various County Projects secured by CAPCOG (Commissioner Showers/Commissioner Mitchell)
  - a. \$4,000,000 has been secured from the state to rebuild Airport Rd from Herbison to Grand River.
  - b. \$1,000,000 has been secured from the state to install water by M-21 (east of St Johns).
  - c. \$1,400,000 has been secured from the feds to install water by M-21 (east of St. Johns).
  - d. \$2,500,000 has been secured from the feds for the Blue Bus Garage project.
